Odd One Out 2

39 x 39 stitches, including the frame 2.79 x 2.79 inches 7.09 x 7.09cm

An introduction to blackwork using just two stitches - back stitch and cross stitch.

By adding extra stitches to Odd One Out 1 the design can be changed to fill the square and create a totally different pattern.

Materials: 14 count Aida 6 x 6 inches

Threads: DMC stranded cotton DMC 310 Black, one skein DMC 995 Electric blue, dark, one skein

Tapestry needle No.24

Stitches used: Back stitch Cross stitch

Method:

Start from the centre of the design and work outwards using one strand of cotton for the back stitch throughout and two strands of cotton for the cross stitch throughout.

Weave in the ends as you go and do not lay threads across open spaces. They will show on the front when you mount your work.
