

Cranes

In China the crane represents long life. It is used on mandarin badges for officials of the first rank.

Materials: 14 count Aida, 12 x 12 inches

Threads: DMC stranded cotton 310 Black, one skein 645 Beaver grey - very dark, one skein 647 Rock grey, one skein 666 Christmas red, one skein 3608 Plum - very light, one skein

Tapestry needle No.24

Stitches used: Back stitch Cross Stitch

Method:

Start from the centre of the design working outwards using ONE strand of cotton for the back stitch and TWO strands for the cross stitch. 647 Rock grey is used for cross stitching the wings and 645 is used for backstitching except where 310 black is used.
