

Beads:

MHG-557 Mill Hill Glass Beads-Gold,
16 beads

Materials: Two 7 x 7 inch squares of 14 count Aida

Threads: DMC stranded cotton 310 Black, one yard 666 Christmas red – bright, two yards 699 Christmas green, one yard DMC Metallic 5382 Gold, one yard

Tapestry needles No. 24 and 26 Sewing needle

Buttonhole thread, white, two yards for lacing Sewing thread, white Two 4 inch diameter card circles Thin wadding 8 inches narrow ribbon in red Egg decoration small beads on a rope, gold – 18 inches or Mill Hill Seed Beads sewn individually around circle edge.

Method:

Fold the square lightly to find the centre. Work outwards using one strand of stranded cotton for the back stitch. Use the metallic thread without splitting for the cross stitch. Add the beads after the embroidery has been completed. Turn face down on a towel and press lightly. Starch if necessary.

To complete Christmas Wishes:

Stick the wadding to the two card circles and trim. Draw a circle in pencil $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches in diameter on the aida and cut out circle. Repeat for both pieces. Work a running stitch near the edge in button thread.

Place card circle onto aida and draw threads tight. Tie off and repeat. Fold ribbon and stitch into place for hanger. Place two fabric circles together and slip stitch.

Stitch egg decoration or gold beads round the edge.
