Red Trio
Using limited colours can produce an effective design which can be repeated or worked as a single motif. Cross stitch can can be worked in a variety of threads ranging from metallics to cotton perle No.12. Use a design such as this to experiment with threads and find the ones which appeal to you

Materials:
28 count evenweave $8 \times 8$ inches or 14 count Aida
Threads:
DMC stranded cotton
310 Black, one skein
917 Plum medium, one skein
3608 plum very light, one skin.
Tapestry needle No. 24
Method
Start from the centre of the design working outwards using two strands of cotton for the cross stitch
When you have finished place the embroidery face down on a towel, spray lightly with starch and press.
