**Design Area:** 2.43" x 2.43" (34 x 34 stitches)

**Backstitch Lines:** 

DMC-310 black — DMM-5284 Dark Gold

Beads:

MHG-81 Mill Hill Glass Beads-Jet

## Interweave

Woven designs look more complicated than they actually are. Use this design for a box top or special card. However, metallic threads are more difficult to use than stranded cotton. If using metallic thread work with lengths no longer than 12 inches and a tapestry needle with a larger eye to avoid fraying the thread.

DMC 680 Old Gold makes a good substitute for gold metallic thread.

Material:

14 count Aida or 28 count evenweave, 7 x 7 inches

DMC Stranded cotton 310 Black 680 Old Gold, or DMC E3852 Gold metallic

Mill Hill Glass beads 81 Jet, nine beads

Tapestry Needle No.24 Beading needle

Stitches used: Back stitch

## Method:

Work from the centre of the design outwards using one strand of cotton for the backstitch. If using E3852 use two strands in short lengths. Add the beads after the embroidery has been completed using matching sewing thread.
