

Victoriana

Stripes and patterned borders figured prominently in Victorian homes on walls and furniture. This delicate border can be repeated and extended as necessary and the colours can be altered to suit.

Materials:

14 count Aida or 26 count evenweave,
9 x 9 inches

Threads:

DMC stranded cotton
910 Dark Emerald, one skein
3607 Pink plum, one skein
3685 Dark mauve, one skein

Tapestry needle No.24

Stitches used:

Back stitch
Cross stitch
Eyelet stitch

Method:

Start from the centre of the design working outwards using ONE strand of cotton for the back stitch and eyelet flower centres and TWO stitches for the cross stitch. Eyelet stitch consists of eight stitches worked from the outside into the central hole. To create a heavier eyelet use two strands.
