This is a small design using some stitches over two squares to create the star. Cross stitches are used to help the beginner count the stitches correctly.

Beads can be added to the centre of each flower for extra texture and sparkle.
Mill Hill Glass Beads 2011 Victorian Gold

Materials:

14 count Aida. 7 x 7 inches

Threads:

DMC stranded cotton
310 Black, one skein
798 Delph Blue - dark, one skein

Tapestry needle No. 24

Beading needle

Method:

Start from the centre of the design working outwards. Use one strand of cotton for the back stitch and two strands for the cross stitch. Work the blackwork border in one strand of cotton.
