This design is based on floor tiles in a Roman villa.

If you have never used beads in blackwork before have fun working the design and adding the beads after you have worked the embroidery.

Materials:

14 count Aida, 8 x 8 inches

Threads:

DMC stranded cotton

500 Blue green - very dark, one skein

Mill Hill Frosted Glass Beads

62031 Gold, one packet

Tapestry needle No.24

Beading needle

Stitches used:

Back stitch

Cross stitch

Method:

Start from the centre of the design working outwards using one strand of cotton for the back stitch and two strands for the cross stitch.

Add the beads after the embroidery has been completed using one strand.
